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Certificate Course in Computer-Aided Drug Designing and Development (CADDD-2025)

The Certificate Course in Computer-Aided Drug Designing and Development (CADDD-2025), organized by the Department of Chemistry in collaboration with the Academy of Chemistry Teachers, aimed to provide students and researchers with practical knowledge and skills in computational drug discovery.

Conducted over 30 hours in a hybrid format (both online and offline), the course covered key topics such as Pharmacogenomics, Molecular Docking, QSAR Modeling, Pharmacokinetics, and Drug Database Screening. Participants were trained using open-source tools like AutoDock, ADMETlab 3.0, and Discovery Studio, and applied their learning through a mini-research project.

A total of 11 participants (9 from TKMM College, Nangiarkulangara, and 2 from MSM College) successfully completed the course, gaining essential research competencies such as data interpretation and scientific communication. The course offered a valuable interdisciplinary platform that connected chemistry with biology, informatics, and pharmacology. Participants gained essential research competencies such as scientific communication, data interpretation, and critical thinking, which are highly relevant for both academic progression and industry placement.

The program was also inclusive and socially responsive. The hybrid model enabled women, especially those on career breaks, and differently-abled students to access quality training using assistive technologies. This emphasis on accessibility and empowerment aligns with MSM College's broader mission of inclusive education and social commitment.

The valedictory function held on June 5, 2025, coinciding with World Environment Day, marked the release of the Course Handbook and the Seminar Proceedings from the National Seminar held earlier in February. The course not only enriched participants' research skills but also strengthened academic networks across institutions.

Overall, CADDD-2025 successfully fostered skill development, interdisciplinary collaboration, and inclusivity, positioning MSM College as a hub for innovation in computational chemistry.
