The Department of Arabic at Milad-E-Sherif Memorial (M.S.M.) College, Kayamkulam, led a dynamic and socially relevant event titled “Zumba Dance Against Drug Abuse” on 8th July 2025 at the Naguib Mahfouz Hall. With the energetic beats of Zumba as its medium, the programme aimed to spread awareness about the dangers of substance abuse while promoting health, unity, and positivity among the student community. Organized under the coordination of Dr. Shanil A., the event brought together 53 participants, including students and faculty from across departments, in a vibrant display of physical fitness and social commitment. The event's theme — “*Say No to Drugs*” — was echoed not only in words but also through action, with participants embodying the spirit of a healthy, active lifestyle.

The Zumba session was designed as both a fitness workout and a social campaign, emphasizing the idea that movement and wellness can be powerful tools in raising awareness about drug prevention. 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Mental Health and Emotional Well-being: A Student-Centered Awareness Session

On 7th July 2025, the Department of Commerce at M.S.M. College, Kayamkulam organized an invited talk titled “Mental Health and Emotional Well-being: A Student-Centered Approach” for first-year undergraduate students. The session, held at the department, was led by Ms. Noora M, Clinical Psychologist at Jeevani, and focused on the emotional and psychological challenges students face during the transition to college life. Ms. Noora engaged the audience through interactive discussions, addressing concerns such as academic pressure, self-esteem, loneliness, and digital burnout. She introduced mindfulness techniques and stress management strategies, emphasizing the importance of balanced routines, self-care, and seeking help when needed. Her empathetic approach created a safe and open environment for students to share their thoughts and experiences.

The session saw the active participation of 37 students, who responded positively to the opportunity to engage in open dialogue about mental health. Feedback indicated a strong appreciation for the relevance of the topic and the practical tools provided. Students expressed interest in attending similar sessions in the future, highlighting the need for continued focus on emotional well-being. This initiative reflects the Department of Commerce’s commitment to fostering a supportive academic environment and promoting mental health awareness as an essential part of student life.

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Equal Voices, Equal Choices: Talk on Gender Equity by the Department of English

On 19th July 2025, the Department of English at M.S.M. College, Kayamkulam, in association with the Parent-Teacher Association (PTA), organized an online gender sensitization programme titled “Equal Voices, Equal Choices.” Held via Google Meet, the session featured a thought-provoking talk by Dr. M.N. Students from undergraduate and postgraduate programmes in Literature and Communicative English actively participated in the session. The speaker’s insightful observations and practical recommendations sparked an engaging discussion, allowing students and faculty to reflect on how gender influences personal identity and social interactions. The programme was coordinated by Ms. Grisha Anand and Ms. B.S. Farzana of the Department of English and saw a total participation of 41 students and faculty members. The event concluded with an interactive Q&A session that further deepened the dialogue on gender sensitivity and inclusivity. “Equal Voices, Equal Choices” stood out as a timely and impactful initiative, reinforcing the department’s commitment to creating an inclusive academic environment grounded in equity, awareness, and empowerment.

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INDUCTION PROGRAMME FOR FYUGP STUDENTS – 2025

MSM College, Kayamkulam, organized an Induction Programme on 11th July 2025 for the first-semester students of the Four-Year Undergraduate Programme (FYUGP). Held at the College Seminar Hall, the event was designed to help students begin their academic journey with awareness, confidence, and a sense of social responsibility. With the participation of 210 students, the programme successfully created a platform for orienting newcomers to the values and support systems integral to campus life.

The programme opened with a strong focus on creating awareness about substance abuse, led by Mr. Praveen P, Preventive Officer from the Department of Excise, Kayamkulam. The session, held in collaboration with Vimukthi, highlighted the legal, social, and health consequences of drug use, especially among youth. Real-life examples and statistics were presented to emphasize the seriousness of the issue, and students were encouraged to take an active role in promoting a drug-free campus. This was followed by a session focusing on mental well-being and emotional support, coordinated by the College Women Cell. Ms. Fia F Shaji, a Consultant Psychologist, addressed the psychological challenges students often face during their transition to college life. She stressed the importance of emotional intelligence, stress management, and building peer support networks. The session offered students practical tools for self-care and encouraged them to seek help when needed, fostering a compassionate and supportive college environment.

To conclude, the issue of ragging and campus safety was addressed by Mr. Eby M S, Sub Inspector of Police. He spoke about the legal consequences of ragging and reiterated MSM College's strict zero-tolerance policy. The session emphasized the importance of respect, inclusion, and mutual responsibility within the student community, reassuring newcomers of the safe and welcoming environment MSM College is committed to upholding. The Induction Programme was marked by enthusiastic student participation and meaningful engagement. 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Techie Teens 2025: Youth Skill Day Celebration at MSM College

To commemorate World Youth Skill Day 2025, the Innovation and Entrepreneurship Development Centre (IEDC) of MSM College, Kayamkulam, in collaboration with the Entrepreneurship Development Club (ED Club) and the Institution's Innovation Council (IIC), organized a two-day digital literacy workshop titled "Techie Teens 2025". The programme, held on 17th and 21st July 2025 at the IEDC Computer Lab, was supported by the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) and generously funded by the Parent-Teacher Association (PTA) of the college.

The workshop aimed to equip school students with basic computer skills, promoting early exposure to digital tools essential for academic and personal development in today's technology-driven world. A total of 137 students from local schools participated in the sessions. The inaugural session on July 17th began with a formal function presided over by Prof. Dr. Muhammed Thaha A, Principal of MSM College. The welcome address was delivered by Dr. Salih N, IEDC Nodal Officer, followed by felicitations from Dr. Divya V (Vice Principal), Mr. C. K. Hariraj (Office Superintendent), and Dr. Lakshmy M (IIC Convenor). Dr. Vidya J, Co-convenor of IEDC, delivered the vote of thanks.

Over the course of two days, participants received hands-on training in essential digital tools, including internet communication, word processing, spreadsheets, graphic design, and basic AI applications. The sessions were designed to be practical and beginner-friendly, encouraging curiosity and confidence among young learners. In line with the college's commitment to social awareness, an anti-drug pledge was administered at the close of each day's training. She discussed its geological features, its influence on Earth's natural systems, and prospects for future lunar habitation and research.

The highlight of the event was a special talk by Dr. Jyothi G, Head of the Department of Physics, who explored the Moon's multifaceted relevance – from cultural symbolism to its role in inspiring future scientific endeavors. Her talk encouraged students to explore careers in astrophysics and space research. This programme not only deepened participants' understanding of lunar science but also sparked curiosity and enthusiasm for space exploration among young minds.
