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## **M.S.M. College Union Election 2025**

The College Union Election 2025 was successfully conducted on 10th October 2025 at the college campus, under the supervision of Returning Officer Dr. Jyothi G Associate Professor of Physics and Additional Returning Officer Dr. Bindya M. S. Associate Professor of Commerce. The election was held in accordance with the University of Kerala guidelines, with support from the Parent-Teacher Association (PTA).

Preparations for the election began with the appointment of election officials and committees in the College Council meeting held on 20th September 2025. A series of meetings involving the Core Committee, Student Affairs Committee, and representatives from the Kerala Police ensured a smooth and transparent conduct of the election.

The electoral roll was published as per the University schedule, and a total of 54 nominations were received, of which 29 candidates remained in the final list after scrutiny and withdrawals. The polling took place peacefully from 10:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. across sixteen booths, with 1134 students and 106 staff members participating.

Robust security arrangements were made by the Kerala Police, including the deployment of a Quick Response Team. Counting began at 2:00 p.m. and concluded smoothly by 6:30 p.m., followed by the announcement of results at 7:00 p.m. The entire process was carried out in a fair and disciplined manner, reflecting the democratic spirit of the institution.




