On 10 September 2025, the ASAP Club at M.S.M. Well-Being

On 10 September 2025, the Department of Commerce organized an interactive session titled

"Emotional Well-Being" for third-semester students. The class was held in the Commerce

Department premises and attended by around 30 students. The resource person for the session

was Ms. Mumtas N, a counsellor from Jeevani.

The session sought to raise awareness among students about the critical role emotional balance

plays in their academic, personal, and social lives. Ms. Mumtas emphasized the importance of

recognizing and managing one's emotions, coping effectively with stress, and building

resilience in the face of life's challenges. She also explained how emotional well-being

influences mental health, academic performance, and relationships, and shared practical tools

such as mindfulness techniques, self-care habits, cultivating positive thinking, and knowing

when and how to seek support.

What made the session especially impactful was the high level of engagement: students freely

shared their own experiences, posed thoughtful questions, and opened up about issues such as

exam anxiety, peer pressure, and adjustment difficulties. Ms. Mumtas responded with empathy

and offered strategies tailored to their concerns.

An interactive Q&A at the end allowed participants to clarify doubts and receive personalized

guidance on maintaining emotional health. In sum, the programme was both informative and

empowering, leaving students better equipped with insights and strategies to nurture their

Jaivakanam – Prakrithi Jaiva Kalavara at Danapady, Haripad. The programme, organized by

the Alappuzha Natural History Society (ANHS), honoured Ms. Vani, recipient of the State

Karshaka Thilakam Award 2025, in recognition of her outstanding contribution to organic

farming.

Spread over four acres, the farm is jointly managed by Mr. Vijith and Ms. Vani Vijith, a couple

committed to promoting organic and sustainable agricultural practices. Their work focuses on

reviving native crop varieties, biodiversity conservation, and community engagement through

eco-friendly initiatives. The team explored various sections of the farm, including organic

cultivation zones, production units, biogas plants, and the local eco-market Prakrithi Jaiva

Kalavara. They learned about native livestock breeds like the Vechur, Krishna, and Kasargod

Dwarf cows, and witnessed sustainable practices such as composting, solar energy use, and

biogas generation.

Students from T.K.M.M. College, Nangiarkulangara, and Christian College, Chengannur also

participated in the visit, which was coordinated by ANHS members Sri. Raveendran, Asokan

Mash, and Dr. Sheela S. The experience offered valuable insights into eco-friendly farming,

waste management, and value-added production, inspiring students to consider green

entrepreneurship in agriculture. The visit concluded at 4:00 p.m., leaving participants with a

deeper understanding of the importance and potential of sustainable farming.

Biotechnology Department Hosts "Phylomap" Workshop on Molecular

Taxonomy Tools

On 16 September 2025, the Department of Biotechnology at M.S.M. College, Kayamkulam,

in collaboration with the Microbiologists Society India (MBSI), conducted a half-day

workshop titled "Phylomap: Workshop on Tools for Molecular Taxonomy" in the Computer

Lab of the Department of Mathematics. The workshop brought together 36 participants,

including students, faculty, and researchers, for an immersive exposure to modern techniques

in molecular taxonomy.

The workshop was led by Dr. Pradeesh Babu from the School of Biotechnology, Amrita Vishwa

Vidyapeetham, Amritapuri, who shared his expertise in phylogenetic analysis, software tools,

and molecular classification methodologies. The session began at 10:00 AM with a welcome

address from Dr. Lekshmi R., Head of the Biotechnology Department, setting the stage for a

day of knowledge exchange.

During the workshop, attendees engaged in hands-on training with relevant software and

databases used in molecular taxonomy and phylogenetic analysis. Practical exercises and

guided demonstrations helped participants gain confidence in analyzing sequence data,

constructing phylogenetic trees, and interpreting taxonomic relationships. The interactive

format allowed for questions, clarifications, and live discussion of real-world scenarios.

The event concluded at 1:30 PM, followed by a vote of thanks from Dr. Deepa I., Assistant

Professor in the Biotechnology Department. Certificates of participation were distributed to all

attendees, and light refreshments were provided throughout. To assess the workshop's impact

and to collect suggestions, feedback was obtained via a Google Form. The responses indicated

enthusiastic approval: participants particularly valued the clarity of instruction, the relevance

of topics to their research interests, and the practical nature of the training.

On 19 September 2025, the Department of Commerce at M.S.M. College hosted a timely seminar titled "An Overview of Forensic Accounting" in the Golden Jubilee Seminar Hall. Commencing at 2:30 pm, the event drew 90 participants, including students and faculty keen to understand the evolving role of forensic accounting in today's financial landscape.

The seminar was inaugurated by Dr. Divya V., Vice-Principal of M.S.M. College, who lauded initiatives that bridge academic learning and professional practice. Dr. Abdul Kalam Azad A., Associate Professor and convener, delivered the welcome address and emphasized the growing importance of forensic accounting in uncovering financial frauds and strengthening corporate governance.

The keynote presentation was delivered by Ms. Beemamol M., an alumna of M.S.M. College and currently a faculty member at NIT Kozhikode. Drawing on her rich experience, she offered a clear and engaging exposition of core concepts such as the integration of accounting, auditing, and investigative techniques. Cherian, Head of the Department, who introduced the resource speaker and underscored the significance of bridging academic learning with industry-relevant skills. The keynote speaker, Mr. Sreejith P. R., a Career Consultant, articulated how NSDC's model of skill development can serve as a catalyst for forging strong career pathways in the accounting and finance sectors.

Mr. Sreejith outlined the core objectives and schemes of NSDC, emphasizing its role in designing skill-based training programs that are aligned with industry demands. He highlighted how NSDC certification enhances credibility with employers, and discussed specific accounting and financial career trajectories empowered through NSDC-endorsed courses. The dialogue helped clarify doubts and spurred enthusiasm about integrating skill development into their professional journey.

The seminar successfully motivated attendees to explore and adopt skill development initiatives as a strategic foundation for their future careers in accounting. The organizers expressed heartfelt gratitude to Mr. Sreejith P. R. for his insightful and inspiring talk, and to all participants for their engaged presence.

The inaugural address was delivered by Ms. Divya V., Vice Principal of M.S.M. By the end, students reported greater confidence in understanding the procedural steps and responsibilities involved in filing complaints.
