Inspire Meet with Alumni – Department of Mathematics

The Department of Mathematics, MSM College, in collaboration with the Mathematics Department Alumni, organised a seminar titled “Inspire Meet with Alumni” on 17 November 2025 at the Mathematics Department classroom. The programme was coordinated by Dr Deepa K. P. and Mr Renjith Kumar Y. and witnessed the participation of 55 students.

The event provided an excellent platform for meaningful interaction between current students and distinguished alumni of the department. During the session, the alumni shared their career journeys, professional experiences, and challenges, offering valuable insights into real-world applications of mathematical education.

The interactive discussions motivated students to pursue their academic and career goals with greater confidence and clarity. The programme was highly beneficial in helping students understand the diverse career pathways available after completing their studies and in strengthening the bond between the department and its alumni.

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Quantum Theory Awareness Programme at MSM College

As part of the lead-up to the Quantum Century Exhibition 2025, organised jointly by the Kerala Sastra Sahitya Parishad (KSSP) and CUSAT at St. Michael's College, Cherthala, the Department of Physics and the Science Club of MSM College, Kayamkulam, hosted a Quantum Theory Awareness Programme on 25 November 2025. The exhibition celebrates the 100th anniversary of Quantum Theory and aims to popularise its concepts among students.

The programme was inaugurated by Dr Muhammed Thaha, Principal of MSM College, with a welcome address by Dr Jyothi G, Head of the Department of Physics. Dr T. Pradeep, District President of KSSP, delivered the keynote talk, offering an engaging introduction to quantum concepts and their significance in modern science. Nisar Ponnarath, Regional Secretary of KSSP, shared detailed information about the upcoming Quantum Exhibition and its various exhibits. Dr Manoj T. R., Kerala University Syndicate Member and HOD of History, offered felicitations, while Dr Divya, Vice Principal, proposed the vote of thanks.

The session was attended by 50 enthusiastic students and faculty members from various departments, who actively engaged in discussions and clarified doubts on quantum theory. The programme successfully sparked curiosity and interest in quantum physics, preparing students for an enriching experience at the Quantum Exhibition.

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Open Lab Programme for Higher Secondary Students

The Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) of MSM College, under the coordination of Dr Anilkumar K. M., successfully organised a two-day Open Lab Programme for Higher Secondary (HSE) students on December 4 and 5, 2025. The programme, conducted with the active collaboration of all Science Departments, transformed the campus into a vibrant centre of scientific exploration and academic orientation.

The initiative welcomed around 200 Higher Secondary students from various schools to bridge the gap between school-level theoretical learning and the practical dimensions of higher education. The programme also aimed to familiarise students with the structure and opportunities offered under the newly introduced Four-Year Undergraduate Programme (FYUGP).

Students were given hands-on exposure to laboratory facilities in the Physics, Chemistry, Botany, Zoology, and Biotechnology departments. The Physics Department showcased demonstrations in optics, electronics, and mechanics, highlighting real-world applications of fundamental concepts. The Chemistry Department engaged students through visually appealing chemical reactions while emphasising the importance of analytical precision and modern instrumentation.

The life science departments offered immersive experiences through specimen studies, microscopy, and demonstrations of contemporary research tools. A major attraction was the Biotechnology Laboratory, where students were introduced to cutting-edge areas such as genetic engineering, tissue culture, and DNA technology, sparking interest in research-oriented careers.

A key highlight of the programme was the orientation session on FYUGP, which helped students understand the flexibility, multidisciplinary approach, and career prospects under the new undergraduate framework. The interactive sessions with faculty members and postgraduate researchers provided valuable academic guidance and informal mentoring. The Open Lab programme successfully fostered scientific temper, curiosity, and career awareness among Higher Secondary students while reinforcing MSM College's commitment to academic outreach and community engagement.

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Knowledge for a Cause: Inter-Departmental Quiz on World AIDS Day 2025

The Science Club, in collaboration with the Environment Activity Club, successfully organized an Inter-Departmental Quiz Competition on 5 December 2025 at the Department of Zoology, MSM College, Kayamkulam, in observance of World AIDS Day 2025. The event aimed to raise awareness about HIV/AIDS, its prevention, treatment, and social impact, while promoting healthy academic interaction among students from different departments.

Eight enthusiastic teams participated in the quiz, demonstrating their knowledge of the scientific, medical, and social aspects of HIV/AIDS. The competition included multiple engaging rounds that tested participants' analytical skills, understanding of preventive measures, diagnostic methods, treatment strategies, and global initiatives related to HIV/AIDS.

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Hands-on Sessions on Water Quality Analysis

The Department of Biotechnology, in association with the Institution's Innovation Council (IIC), Innovation and Entrepreneurship Development Centre (IEDC), and Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC), successfully conducted a one-day Hands-on Session on Water Quality Analysis (Chemical and Biological) on 06 December 2025 at the Biotechnology Laboratory, MSM College, Kayamkulam. The programme was organised with the support of Samagra Shiksha Kerala, BRC Kayamkulam, as part of the STREAM ecosystem and Ministry of HRD initiatives.

The programme was inaugurated by the Principal, Prof. (Dr) A. Muhammed Thaha, who highlighted the importance of experiential learning and environmental awareness among young learners. Felicitations were offered by the Educational Secretary, MSM College, Dr S. Amina, who emphasised the role of higher education institutions in community outreach and school-level scientific engagement.

A total of 37 students from seven different schools participated in the workshop. The participants brought water samples collected from various local sources, which were analysed during the sessions. The workshop provided intensive, hands-on training in both chemical and biological analysis of water, encompassing tests for pH, hardness, total dissolved solids (TDS), conductivity, the presence of contaminants, and microbial load.

The sessions were led by Dr Lakshmy M (Department of Chemistry), Dr Vidya J (Department of Biotechnology), and Ms Christeena John, with active support from student leaders of the Chemistry, Biotechnology, and Commerce departments who are members of IIC and IEDC. Participants worked in small groups, gaining direct exposure to laboratory instruments and techniques under expert supervision.

The programme proved to be an effective experiential learning platform, fostering scientific temper, environmental consciousness, and practical skill development among school students. The workshop successfully achieved its objective of promoting interdisciplinary learning while strengthening the college's commitment to community-oriented scientific outreach.

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Physics Department Educational Visit: Quantum Century Exhibition & AR–VR Familiarisation

On 15 December 2025, the Physics Department organised an educational visit for 25 undergraduate and postgraduate students to enhance academic exposure to emerging scientific and technological concepts. The visit was supervised by Dr Jyothi G and Sefeena A.

The first stop was the Quantum Century Exhibition at St. Michael's College, Cherthala, where students explored interactive exhibits on quantum science and its real-world applications in computing, communication, and materials science. The exhibition made complex concepts accessible and encouraged curiosity and critical thinking.

The second part of the visit took place at ASAP Skill Park, Cheriya Kalavoor, where students participated in an AR–VR Familiarisation Programme. Hands-on demonstrations allowed participants to experience immersive virtual environments, gaining practical insights into applications of AR and VR in education, healthcare, engineering, and training.

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Sustainable Waste Management Through Fish Harvesting at MSM College

The Department of Zoology, in collaboration with the Alumni Association of Zoology, conducted a fish harvest from the waste-fed fish culture system on 16 December 2025 at MSM College. The initiative, supported by the BSc Zoology Alumni (1988–1991 batch), uses campus food waste to feed fish, providing a sustainable method for organic waste management.

Faculty members and 45 students of the Zoology Department actively participated. After harvesting and weighing the fish, they were returned to the tank to continue the cycle of waste treatment and growth. 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NSS Scrap Collection Drive
