National Level Seminar: “Digital Transformation in Pharmaceutical R&D”

The Department of Chemistry, in association with R&D Cell, IIC, IEDC, and IQAC, organised a National Level Seminar on “Digital Transformation in Pharmaceutical R&D” on 17 January 2026 via Zoom, with 45 participants. The programme was conducted under the patronage of Haji P. A. Hilal Babu, Manager-cum-Secretary, MSM Trust of Institutions, and convened by Dr. Divya V. The inaugural session included addresses by Ms Advaita R. Prasad, Dr Neethu Sundaresan, and Dr Zameer K. H., and was attended by distinguished invitees and members of the Chief Organizing Committee, including Dr. Manoj T. R., Member, Syndicate, University of Kerala, Prof. (Dr.) S. Amina, Education Secretary, MSM Institutions, Dr Anilkumar K. M., IQAC Coordinator, Dr Salih N., Nodal Officer, IEDC, Mr Hariraj C. K., Office Superintendent, Abhijith S. Babu, College Union Chairman, along with faculty members of the Department of Chemistry and representatives from the associated cells, faculty, and student representatives.

The technical sessions featured a keynote address by Dr Raghu Rangaswamy on AI/ML and rational drug design, an invited lecture by Dr Vellarkad Viswanadhan on binding free energy predictions, and application-oriented demonstrations by Mr Anbu Dinesh and Dr Faizan Syed on AI/ML in retrosynthesis, generative AI, and ultra-large chemical space docking.

The seminar successfully enhanced participants’ understanding of digital tools in pharmaceutical R&D, provided insights into AI/ML applications in drug discovery, and strengthened academic–industry interaction. Faculty members, students, research scholars, and industry professionals gained practical knowledge, fostering collaboration and innovation in pharmaceutical research.

The IIC and IEDC, in collaboration with the Departments of Chemistry, Biotechnology, and Zoology, organised a Strategic Proposal & Critical Review Session for THELIMA ANALYTICS, the first student-led start-up initiative from MSM College, on 23 January 2026 at the College Conference Hall, with 50 participants.

The proposal, presented by Sreenanda V (Semester 2, FYUGP Biotechnology), focused on science-based solutions for water purity and public health under the theme “Pure Water, Pure Life: Science for Society.” This session served as the initial evaluation before submission to the Kerala Start-up Mission.

Faculty members, mentors, and participants critically reviewed the proposal, discussing scientific feasibility, technological innovation, scalability, market potential, and social impact, and provided constructive suggestions to refine the research framework, strengthen the business model, improve data validation, and enhance long-term impact. The session helped the presenter gain clear guidance for improvement and fostered interdisciplinary collaboration, reinforcing MSM College’s commitment to student-led research, innovation, and start-up development.
