## **Scientific Social Responsibility (SSR) Seminar – Research Methodology and Ethical Integrity**

The Department of Zoology, Milad-E-Sherief Memorial College, Kayamkulam, organised a seminar on “Research Methodology and Ethical Integrity” on 05 February 2026 at the FYUGP classroom of the department. The programme was coordinated by Dr Bindu L. in association with the University of Kerala under the DST-WISE Scientific Social Responsibility (SSR) initiative. A total of 33 participants, including B.Sc., M.Sc. students, and faculty members, attended the session.

The seminar began at 10:30 a.m., with Dr Bindu L. introducing the resource person, Ms Amina Taj, Full-time Research Scholar, University of Kerala, Kariavattom. The session focused on research methodology, ethical integrity, report writing, and publication strategies.

The speaker explained key components of research, including problem identification, objectives, methodology, data collection, and analysis, clearly and systematically. The use of visual presentations made the session engaging and easy to comprehend. An interactive discussion followed, where participants actively clarified their doubts.

## ***JEEVANRAKSHA – Suicide Prevention Workshop***

A half-day workshop titled “JEEVANRAKSHA – Suicide Prevention” was organised on 05 March 2026 at the Seminar Hall, Department of Arabic, Milad-E-Sherief Memorial College, Kayamkulam. The programme was coordinated by Smt. Sajitha and Smt. ## Water Analysis Workshop

The Bhoomithrasena Club and the Institution Innovation Council of Milad-E-Sherief Memorial College organized a Water Analysis Workshop on 05 March 2026 at the B.Sc. Zoology Laboratory, in collaboration with the Departments of Chemistry and Zoology. The programme was coordinated by Dr. Bindu L.

The workshop aimed to provide fundamental knowledge on water quality assessment and to create awareness about water testing, environmental protection, and public health. It covered both theoretical and practical aspects, including sources of contamination and health impacts.

Participants studied physical (colour, odour, turbidity, temperature), chemical (pH, hardness, alkalinity, dissolved oxygen, BOD, COD, nitrates, chlorides), and biological (microbial contamination, including coliform bacteria) parameters.

Water samples were collected at 10:30 a.m. from the Khadeesha Bridge area near the KSRTC stand, a nearby lake near the Boat Race Pavilion, and from the college laboratory. Analysis began at 1:30 p.m. The analysis commenced at 1:30 p.m. under the guidance of Dr Deepa R. Pillai and Dr Bindu L. from the Department of Zoology, along with Ms Sunitha V. and Ms Christina from the Department of Chemistry.

A total of 35 participants, including students, faculty members, and research scholars, took part in the workshop. They received hands-on training using testing kits and laboratory instruments, enhancing their practical skills and ability to interpret results. The workshop concluded at 4:00 p.m.
