## **Educational Tour – Trip 23–26**

The Department of Commerce, Milad-E-Sherief Memorial College, Kayamkulam, organised an Educational Tour titled “Trip 23–26” from 30 January 2026 to 04 February 2026 under the coordination of Dr Swapna K. Cherian and Ms Shafeena S. A total of 53 students participated in the tour. The trip covered major destinations including Coorg, Chikmagalur, Belur, and Wayanad.

The tour began on 30 January 2026 with the departure from the college at 3:00 pm. On arrival at Coorg, students visited Harangi Dam and the Tibetan Monastery (Golden Temple) and explored the Bamboo Forest. The day concluded with cultural activities and an overnight stay. On 1<sup>st</sup> February 2026, the group travelled to Chikmagalur, where students experienced jeep trekking to scenic locations including Mullayangiri, Baba Budan Giri, Honnamanna Falls, 360° View Point, and Z Point, enjoying the natural beauty of the Western Ghats.

On 2<sup>nd</sup> February 2026, the team proceeded to Belur, where students participated in water activities such as kayaking, rafting, and banana rides. They also visited the historic Belur Temple and Yagachi Dam before travelling to Wayanad for an overnight stay. On 3<sup>rd</sup> February 2026, students explored popular destinations in Wayanad, including Edakkal Caves, Pookode Lake, and Lakkidi View Point, followed by the return journey from Kozhikode after dinner.

The group reached the college on the morning of 4<sup>th</sup> February 2026. The educational tour provided students with experiential learning, exposure to new places and cultures, and opportunities for teamwork and personal development, making it both informative and memorable.

## **Nature Camp at Eravikulam National Park**

The Political Science Department, Milad-E-Sherief Memorial College, Kayamkulam, organised a three-day Nature Camp from 30 January to 1 February 2026 at Eravikulam National Park, Munnar, in collaboration with the Kerala Forest Department. The programme was coordinated by Advaita R. Prasad, and 29 students, along with three faculty members, participated.

During the camp, participants engaged in guided trekking sessions within the national park, observing the rich biodiversity of the Western Ghats. Forest officials conducted awareness sessions on biodiversity conservation, wildlife protection, and the ecological significance of forests.

The programme provided students with practical exposure to environmental conservation and an understanding of the role of forest authorities in preserving ecosystems. Certificates were awarded to all participants by officials from the Kerala Forest Department. The camp significantly enhanced students' environmental awareness, fostered appreciation for biodiversity, and highlighted the importance of sustainable interaction with nature.
